The Journal of Agricultural Investment (JAI) is a refereed scientific journal, issued by the Arab Authority for Agricultural Investment and Development (AAID).

Scope of Publications

JAI publishes original articles, studies, and research papers of high scientific merit with clear practical impact in the following aspects :

- Agricultural research of applied nature.
- Technical sectorial studies, economics and marketing of the main agricultural products in the Arab countries and the world.
- Studies and evaluation of pilot investment projects.
- Scientific articles addressing a specialized agricultural topic associated with practical application and investment.
- Articles to highlight the most recent technology related to the development of the agricultural sectors.
- Recent advances in agriculture.
- Highlighting pioneer agricultural projects and achievements in the Arab World.

Guidelines for Publication in JAI

Papers and articles are accepted in English or Arabic with a summary in the other language. Articles and review papers should not exceed 8 pages, and re-

search papers 6 pages. Manuscripts should be typewritten or wordprocessed on one side of A4 paper, single-spaced and submitted in one original and a floppy disk.

Articles and Review Papers

Articles and review papers should include: a title, introduction, subject matter, recommendations, views, and references.

Research Papers

Content of a research paper should include :

Title

It must be concise and specific, followed by full author (s) name and addresses.

Summary

It should show the salient points of the paper and the main results and findings (not exceeding 300 words) followed by keywords not exceeding 4 words.

Introduction

It should provide adequate background for the study, justification, objectives and relevant references.

Materials and Methods

It should include detailed description of materials

and methods, experimental design, operations, samples, observations, and statistical analysis of data.

Results

Presentation of the results obtained using self-explanatory tables or figures, diagrams, graphs or photos. Levels of significance and standard errors for comparison of treatment means should be given.

Discussion

Adequately offers scientific explanations for the results obtained, taking into account the idea and objectives of the study. Findings of the study should be compared with the results of previously published work.

References

References should be listed in alphabetical order of surnames, and should include the authors surname, initials, year of publication, title, name of the journal, volume number, and pages number. Arabic references should be listed first.

Failure to comply with these instructions may delay or stand against publication.

Evaluation

Manuscripts are initially reviewed by the Editorial Board to ensure their relevance to the scope and style
